OLAYINKA HAKEEM BABALOLA SELECTED TO BE 2026-27 ROTARY INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT



Olayinka Hakeem Babalola, a member of the Rotary Club of Trans Amadi, Nigeria, has been selected by the Board of Directors to become Rotary International's president

for 2026-27. His term will begin on 1 July 2026.

The Board, guided by the RI code of policies, conducted a special session to select the organization's leader after the resignation of RI President-elect SangKoo Yun, who decided to step back from his Rotary responsibilities and focus on his recovery from recent cancer treatment.

Babalola began his Rotary journey in 1988 as a Rotaractor. He joined the Rotary Club of Trans Amadi six years later. His leadership roles include serving as district governor (2011-12), RI vice president (2019-20), and member of the RI Board (2018-20). He was also an active leader and participant in RI committees such as the End Polio Now Countdown to History Campaign Committee (2017-23) and the Nigeria National PolioPlus Committee (2013-present, adviser 2016-present).

An attorney, Babalola received a university degree in engineering in 1988. He has worked for 25 years in the oil and gas industry, holding senior positions in Shell PLC and carrying out projects on four continents. He is the founder of two companies: Riviera Services Ltd., an oil and gas infrastructure delivery company, and Lead and Change Consulting, an executive coaching and organizational performance advisory group.

Babalola's professional affiliations include the Nigerian Society of Engineers, the Institute of Safety Professionals, and the Association of Change Management Practitioners. He is a member of Jericho Business Club, an organization in his home city that provides input to governments on economic and social policy.

Babalola and his wife, Preba, live in the city of Port Harcourt. He supports The Rotary Foundation with a named endowment and as an Arch Klumph Society member. A trustee of ShelterBox UK and director of the Safe Blood Africa project, he is a recipient of the Africa Centennial Heroes Award, the Regional Service Award for a Polio-Free World, the RI Service Above Self Award, and The Rotary Foundation Citation for Meritorious Service.

The president of Rotary International serves a one-year term, presiding over the Board of Directors and providing inspirational leadership for the organization. As the spokesperson for the global network, the president visits clubs around the world to promote Rotary's values and represent the organization at major events. Rotary chooses its president from members who have demonstrated extensive leadership experience within Rotary, including service as a club president, district governor, and member of the Board.

From the meticulous planning to the seamless execution, and from the world-class speakers to the powerful, thought-provoking messages delivered – everything reflected the true spirit of Rotary’s values and vision. Hats off to Rtn. Muruganandam, RI Director (2025–27), whose passion and commitment made this phenomenal event possible in India."

For me, Leads 25 was more than just an event. It was an eye-opening experience that gave us an opportunity to understand Rotary at a much larger scale, witness its sustainable goals in action, and feel truly proud to be a part of this extraordinary movement.

रोटरी क्लब जळगावने या काव्य पंक्तीनुसार विद्यार्थ्यांच्या चारित्र्य निर्माणासाठी एक प्रकल्प हाती घेतला आहे. Location: Magnum Hospital, Nashik

Rotary Service Area: Community Service

Rotary Avenue of Service: Disease Prevention and Treatment

Project: Paediatric Heart Surgeries under Global Grant – Cath Lab Project

Summary of Activity:

On 24th August 2025, the Rotary Club facilitated

life-saving paediatric heart surgeries at Magnum Hospital, Nashik, under the Global Grant – Cath Lab Project. This initiative is part of Rotary's commitment to community service and aligns with the Rotary Avenue of Disease Prevention and Treatment.

Beneficiaries:

A total of 12 children, aged between 5 to 12 years, hailing from remote areas of the Nashik district, received treatment for congenital heart diseases (primarily holes in the heart). These conditions were identified during a health camp organized earlier by Magnum Hospital.

Without intervention, such heart conditions severely impact quality of life and longevity. The successful surgeries will enable these children to lead healthy and normal lives.

In private healthcare facilities, similar surgeries typically cost between ₹1.5 lakhs to ₹5 lakhs – a burden that is unaffordable for many rural families. Through this project, the Rotary Club has ensured equitable access to vital healthcare.

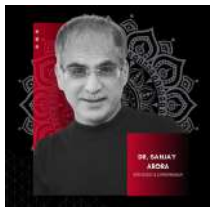

निमंत्रण मिलना मेरे लिए अविस्मरणीय क्षण था। गर्व की अनुभूति हुई, लेकिन साथ ही विनम्रता भी महसूस हुई, क्योंकि यह निमंत्रण केवल मेरा नहीं था; यह हमारे संपूर्ण रोटरी 3030 परिवार के कार्य की पहचान थी। हमारे प्रयासों को वैश्विक स्तर पर मान्यता मिल रही है, यह भावना मुझे और अधिक सार्थक संदेश तैयार करने के लिए प्रेरित करती है।

युवा रोटेरियन के लिए मेरा संदेश है कि वे अपनी ऊर्जा, नवाचार और डिजिटल कौशल रोटरी में लाएँ। इससे संस्था प्रासंगिक और गतिशील बनी रहेगी। रोटरी के मूल्यों को थामे रखते हुए नई सेवा-पद्धतियाँ अपनाने से न डरें। और सबसे महत्वपूर्ण बात – सेवा आनंद के साथ करें, क्योंकि खुशहाल सेवा ही रोटरी की आत्मा है।
